Children can be dropped off at the correct venue no earlier than 8.30am and will need to be collected between 3.30pm- 4.30pm.

Children will need to bring their own packed lunch and drink. There will be more details to follow nearer the time..

We would encourage parents to sign up for the camps early.

The cost is £150 for the whole week or £35 per day. This represents great value for money as the children have a wonderful time enjoying many activities.
